Prescribed burning within meadow habitat and edges to enhance and restore native meadow communities and rare plant populations.

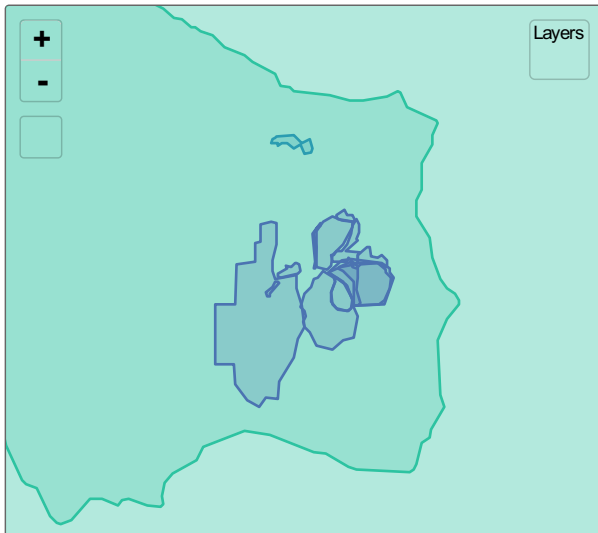
